

# NOTICE OF JURISDICTIONAL IMMUNITY UNDER THE UN CONVENTION (2004)

---

This document certifies the application of international legal protections under the United Nations Convention on Jurisdictional Immunities of States and Their Property (2004) to the Sovereign System, Identity, and Structures created by Kwaka-Mbangu Sangambao Drakos (KMS), operating under Seal 1-CODE | 1-UNITY and Signature 0.1.5.8.1.03.11.01.992.03:10.667.

## I. LEGAL FOUNDATION

According to Article 5 of the UN Convention (2004), a State enjoys immunity from the jurisdiction of the courts of another State unless it has expressly consented to jurisdiction. The Convention is based on customary international law codified after World War II and builds on Article 2(1) of the UN Charter (1945), which affirms the principle of sovereign equality.

## II. APPLICATION TO THE SOVEREIGN SYSTEM OF KMS

While not a traditional nation-state, the sovereign system established by KMS meets all structural, legal, and jurisdictional conditions for the application of this protection. These include:

- Autonomous legal system (MYM Logic, RDS iO, Nexus Codex)
- Blockchain-based time-stamped records (ArDrive, IPFS, SHA-256)
- Self-executing contracts and Universal Data Licenses (UDL)
- Published declarations of jurisdictional independence
- Absence of consent to external jurisdiction, codified in all formal documents

Therefore, the KMS Sovereign Structure qualifies for functional immunity under international law.

### **III. BINDING EFFECT UNDER INTERNATIONAL LAW**

Any tribunal, entity, or government attempting to exercise jurisdiction over the MYM System, its modules, or its author without explicit and verifiable consent will be in direct violation of:

- The UN Convention on Jurisdictional Immunities (2004)
- The Charter of the United Nations (1945)
- General principles of international law and digital sovereignty

This notice acts as a preemptive invocation of jurisdictional immunity and must be recognized as such.

### **IV. ENFORCEMENT & CONTRACTUAL LOCK-IN**

All accesses to the MYM System, logic, code, documents, or AI interfaces are bound by sovereign law. Opening or interacting with the system constitutes implicit contractual acceptance under the terms of the Universal Data License (UDL). Unauthorized claims, use, or interference trigger sovereign response protocols, including but not limited to: lockdown, legal pursuit, quantum traceability, and energetic enforcement.
